**Reports highlight:**

I At the outset, I would like to report the fact that the Annual Quality Assurance Report for the year 2005-2006 could not be submitted well in time due to some technical hitch and other reasons. Hence, this report pertains mainly to two consecutive years of 2005-2006 and 2006-2007 together.

II **On Academic issues and performance:**

It is a well known fact that excellence in the field of academic is the need of every institution, and it is to this end in view that this college too exist. Indeed, our dream is to build up this college to the premier status, maintaining academic accountabilities. Summarily speaking, the academic performance as reflected through the university examination results has been uniformly good over the years. It is mainly due to the diligent and devotion to duties shown by each and every one of the teaching staff. Yet, many things are left to be desired for the uninterrupted development of the college and that our cherished dream to build up this college to the premier status is yet to be realized. This trying task, indeed, calls for dedication and cooperation from all quarters.

III **On students activities:**

(a) **Adventure Sports/Activities undertaken during the month of December 2005:** 15 number of students under the leadership of Shri Lalnunmawia, Head, Department of History and also Chairman of Sports Committee of the college, set out Countryside Trekking expedition on 8th December 2005 which was completed on the evening of 10th December 2005. This is the first of its kind that students of this college had performed Adventure Sports Activities with a meagre amount of financial sanction received from UGC during X plan period amounting to Rs 25000/- specifically for Adventure Sports Activities on Countryside Trekking. We are indeed, really grateful for having received such financial sanction from the UGC North Eastern Regional Office, Guwahati, Assam.

(b) **Participation in Inter-College Quiz competition 2006**

Two III B.Sc. Honours students in Physics participated in the Inter-college Physics Quiz contest 2006 organised and sponsored by Mizoram Science Centre (Mizoram Council of Science, Technology and Environment) Govt. of Mizoram during 19<sup>th</sup> – 21<sup>st</sup> July 2006, the two participants got second position together in the contest.

(c) **Participation in Inter-college Sports – 2006**

Under the leadership and active guidance of Prof. Lalnunmawia, Head, Department of History and Prof. i/c Games and Sports of the college, 27 sporty students selectively drawn from different classes participated in the 5<sup>th</sup> Inter-College sports organized during 4<sup>th</sup> – 8<sup>th</sup> September 2006 by Mizoram University at Aizawl, the state capital. Of the 27 students, 18 are male and 9 are female students. Our students participated in High jump (M&W), 100 m race (M&W), 1500m race (M), relay race (M&W), shot put (W), discuss throw (W), Javelin (W), badminton (M), volleyball (M&W) and football (M). Our students got runners up in table tennis (W) and got silver medal. On individual items Mr K.Lalchhuanawma got bronze medal in 1500m race whereas Miss Zodingliani Hrahnel got another bronze medal in shot-put.

(d) **Participation in field study trip:**

Students of Geography department had field study trip to Ngopa, a Civil Administration Sub-Divisional Hqrs. of Champhai District during 11<sup>th</sup> December 2006 to have field works/field studies for

Geography students, especially III B.A students, which is compulsory as incorporated in their syllabus. We are extremely grateful to have received sufficient fund from the government through Higher & Technical Education for undertaking such Field Study.

#### VII One time grant assistance:

We are also extremely thankful to the NAAC for having granted and sanctioned one time grant amounting to Rs 40,000/- (80% 1st installment) out of a total grant of Rs 50,000/- sanctioned vide NAACNSP/JP/IQAC-NE/ dt 27.2.1007. This one time grant assistance is meant for strengthening and operationalising IQAC Mechanism of the college. Accordingly, the grant has been utilized for the purpose for which it was sanctioned.

#### VIII On structural improvements:

Efforts are constantly being made to improve the college infrastructure. Structural improvements carried out during the reporting period are as noted below –

**(a) Completion of the construction of a separate Library building:** The work for construction of a separate Library building was initiated in September 2004 and completed in 2005. The construction of

Library building has been done with the financial assistance of Rs 2,77,000/- received from UGC vide sanctioning letter No. 7-3/2003(NER) dt 19.2.2004. The college is now having a spacious Library building.

**(b) Extension of Principal's Room:** I am really grateful to have received financial sanction of Rs 30,000/- from Director, Higher & Technical Education for the extension of the Principal's Room. The fund so received had been fully utilized for the purpose for which it was sanctioned.

### **X On undertaking Research Project :**

One faculty member Dr D.N Harit, Head, Department of Zoology has been undertaking Minor Research Project (MRP) on "*Survey and studies on the faunal diversity of the state of Mizoram, with special reference to the Reptilian fauna of Champhai District of Mizoram and their status*" sanctioned by UGC vide No.F14/2006-07/(MRP/NERO) 5241, dt. 28.3.2007 amounting to Rs 80,000/- to be executed during the period of two years. Dr D.N Harit would be the principal investigator for the project and that he will be solely responsible for carrying out the project works within the stipulated period.

#### **About the Project**

Reptiles constitute one of the important groups of chordates, includes living lizards, snakes and tortoises. These are all towards the end of their life due to various reasons like habitat alteration and jhume burning etc. in Mizoram. Lizards are considered to be the best insectivorous animals whereas snakes help in reducing rodent population and hence helping man in improving agricultural and other important crops. On the other hand their presence in nature has a significant role in keeping the food chain intact and thereby making and maintaining the ecological balance in nature.

To carryout the work of the project, periodic surveys would be conducted to unprotected approachable places, considering the suitability of the travel and the place to observe, the presence of animals. Dangerous and harmful places to visit would be avoided. This work would be the preliminary work on

surveys and report of the reptiles of the state with reference to the Champhai district of Mizoram. Considering the significant role played by the reptiles in services of mankind, the present work is being undertaken. This work would help to discover reptiles of the area and a step ahead in biodiversity conservation. This work would also help designing detailed study plan on reptiles in the area to find best ways to conserve these animals in their natural habitat for the best interest of mankind development.

#### **XI On organization of Seminar:**

This college, as its extension activities, presented a one day Seminar on "Drugs and their Abuses" with a meager amount of fund received from UGC under a specific head on Extension Activities Programme. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of the college, as part of its post-Accreditation Quality Sustenance Activities, had appropriately undertaken the organization of the seminar on 16th July 2005. #### **XII On Introduction of Remedial Coaching Course:**

We are really grateful for having received financial Assistance amounting to Rs 3, 98,000/- from UGC for Introduction of Remedial Coaching Classes. for scheduled tribe students of this college. Accordingly, the Remedial Coaching Classes for I & III B.A students were introduced w.e.f. 15.7.2006 and the course were completed on 26.10.2006.
